- 03 Check dates, source documents and professional advice before acting.
- 04 Revisit the page when new information arrives.

Respect and trust

USE THIS PAGE

Write an observed example, not a rating of a person.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Fictional: 'They listened when I changed my mind about a visit' is an observation.

What I observed and when

What felt supportive or concerning

What I need to understand

Who I can speak with safely

Money and shared choices

USE THIS PAGE

Name an expectation and a question for a later talk.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Fictional: One partner expects separate savings and the other has never discussed it.

My money expectation

What has actually been discussed

Difference or missing information

One question or next step

Conflict, boundaries and care

USE THIS PAGE

Look for patterns in how disagreement and boundaries are handled.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Fictional: The reader notices that a pause request was respected and records what happened.

Recent concrete example

Boundary or need

How each person responded

What support or follow-up I want

My clarity page

USE THIS PAGE

Keep the decision yours; share only what feels safe.

WORKED EXAMPLE

Fictional: The reader decides to ask for premarital counseling before making a timeline.

What feels clear

What remains uncertain

What I will not rush
